



Areas to Highlight

- A 165km digitally and physically waymarked historic trail following in the footsteps of 1,490 famine emigrants during the famine in 1847.
- The trail runs from Strokestown Park, Co. Roscommon (trailhead) to EPIC The Irish Emigration Museum in Dublin Docksland, along country pathways and the Royal Canal towpath.
- Along the Route: The trail is waymarked by 32 poignant sculptures of bronze 19th-century children's shoes.

Trail Maps

There are three types of OSI maps: illlustrative trail map, county map and map of Ireland.

- Interactive Google map on the app, which shows you exactly where you are on the trail and indicates the bronze shoes.
- Static map: details of detours at interesting points along the route are shown in orange on the map, available on the app or in the official pack.
